SCPS #9: Storm the Beach, Dec 9th, 2007

The course: Wide FAST dirt roads. Deep sand sections and long, rideable hard-pack beach section. Small climbs with a few technical turns, and barrier section(s). Bleachers near the start/finish offer great views of the course, as well as the beautiful Pacific Coast shoreline. Races are timed circuits on the course based on race category. Kid's Course is separate from the main course, so bring the young ones and their bikes for racing and "time trials"!

Location/Directions: Immediately west of Interstate 5 Freeway off the Las Pulgas Exit. "Red Beach", Camp Pendleton, California is located in North San Diego County between Oceanside and San Clemente. Approximately one (1) hour South of downtown Los Angeles, or North of downtown San Diego. From I-5 Freeway (north or southbound), exit LAS PULGAS Road. Go WEST on Pulgas Rd, proceed through the yellow gate onto a dirt road toward the ocean to the parking area.

Important: Please park (and ride) only in designated areas. Through much coordination, Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton has graciously authorized* the use of "Red Beach" specifically for this race. Please do not wander down the beach or trails outside the race course perimeter. Ensure you have a driver's license, proof of insurance, and registration when entering the Base. (*Authorization to use Camp Pendleton does not constitute endorsement by the Base Commander nor the United States Marine Corps.)

Entries: All category entries are \$25. Additional race entry fees are just \$5. JUNIOR RACE CATEGORIES ARE FREE. Annual or one-day USA Cycling licenses are required. One-day USA Cycling licenses will be available for \$10 at registration, including Juniors. Juniors must pay for category races if not racing Junior race category. There are No Late Fees.

Registration: Pre-register at Sports Base Online (www.sportsbaseonline.com/Series.aspx?id=273). Every effort will be made to give priority at check to pre-registered racers. On-line registration closes Thursday 9:00pm 12/6/07. Race day registration opens at 8:30am on Sunday. A valid USA Cycling license required. (NORBA/USCF). One-Day racing license available for purchase. An annual USA Cycling license can be purchased on race day or online at www.USAcycling.org prior to the event. Registration for each category closes 15 minutes before the race start. All events are held rain or shine. Results will be posted at the event and at www.SoCalCross.org.

Rules: USCF cyclocross rules apply. CYCLOCROSS AND MOUNTAIN BIKES (No Bar ends) ARE WELCOME. Bike and wheel changes are allowed in the designated pit areas. Riders must wear helmets at all times when on the bike. Riders shall stay on the course or existing trails.

Categories: For a rider getting his/her first license, he/she starts at CX Category 4 and then upgrades by earning points. For returning riders, their CX category is determined by using the guidelines below:

If the rider has a USCF license:

Road Cat 1 or Pro = CX cat 1

Road cat 2 = CX cat 2

Road cat 3 = CX cat 3

Road cat 4 or 5 = CX cat 4

If the rider has a NORBA license:

Pro = CX cat 1

Semi-pro = CX cat 2

Expert = CX cat 3

Beginner or sport = CX cat 4

If the rider is both, then they get the higher of the categories. This guideline is just a starting point - Each local association and regional coordinators will be in a position to modify a rider's CX category if their knowledge of the rider and his/her results indicate a more appropriate category.
