Presents the 21st Annual Mark Reynolds San Luis Rey Road Cycling Classic Sunday, May 4, 2008

Part of the 2008 SCNCA SoCal Riders Cup Series
Held under USA Cycling event permit

ENTRIES: Online at www.SportsBaseOnline.com and must be made by April 30, 2008, 8:45PM, PT. There will be a \$5 late fee for on-site registration. Release forms for online registration will be signed at race day registration. Riders under 18 must have a parent/legal guardian signature on the release form. Unattached riders pay an additional \$5 (except Men Cat 5 & Women Cat 4) at registration. Additional races are \$10 and the discount is handled with the online entry. Entry fee includes \$2 USCF insurance surcharge.

NO REFUNDS. Unlicensed riders may enter Men Cat 5, Master Men 55+, Master Men 60+, and Women Cat 4 the day of the event by buying a \$10 one-day USCF license at registration. Current USCF National Road Race champions (ONLY) race free, by paying the entry fee and making a request at race day registration for return of the fee.

REGISTRATION: Registration at Sullivan Middle School opens 1 hr. before each race & closes 15 minutes before start. All riders must present USCF license. Unlicensed riders may buy a \$10 one-day USCF license (Men Cat 5, Master Men 55+, Master Men 60+, and Women Cat 4). A category with less than a minimum field size of 4, at the close of registration, may be combined (along with cash & prizes for that category), and scored separately, with another race.

RULES: Rain or shine. All USCF rules apply. Helmets must be worn while on the bike. The course is open to traffic. CROSSING THE CENTERLINE WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION! Joining or receiving assistance from anyone in another race will result in disqualification. Feeding will be allowed only in the marked area on the hill located on Old Highway 395. Wheel support is provided for Pro/1/2 men only. Wheels in, wheels out. **NO UNAUTHORIZED FOLLOW VEHICLES ALLOWED.**

* A second Men Cat 5 race will be added at 10:25 if the field limit exceeds 50 and the minimum field size for the second race is greater than 4 at the close of registration on the day of the event. Registration for this second Men Cat 5 race can be done online after the first Men Cat 5 race reaches the field limit or register for it on the day of the event.

COURSE: A hilly 11.6-mile loop on well-paved roads. Climb immediately from the start up West Lilac, turn right on Old Hwy 395, descend on Old Hwy 395 to Camino Del Rey, right on Camino Del Rey to West Lilac, turn right. Start/Finish at Sullivan Middle School, approx. 1/2 way up West Lilac. Total climbing per lap is 950 feet. Course map at www.celopacific.org.

DIRECTIONS: From I-15: Exit at Old Hwy 395 (between Temecula and Escondido) and travel 1 mile north to West Lilac. Turn left down the hill to Sullivan Middle School.

From I-5: Exit at Hwy 76 in Oceanside and travel 15 miles east to Old Hwy 395. Turn right (South) 2 miles & turn right on West Lilac to Sullivan Middle School.
